Clinical Pastoral Education

Looking for a way to continue your professional education in a vibrant and personal way?
Do you or a colleague want to grow in your ministry skills?

We invite you to consider taking a unit of CPE (Clinical Pastoral Education.) CPE is a form of education in which ministry professionals and students provide pastoral care and then reflect together in a small groups about their experiences.

This unit of CPE combines students in hospital settings with students in community-based settings. CPE Education aids in ministerial and professional development, and helps us look beyond the surface of what happens in ministry. CPE aids students in identifying issues that present themselves and seeing the larger picture of who they are and how they do ministry.

Details

- Calendar: Monday mornings from November 2018 through April 2019
- Tuition: \$700 at OhioHealth site (Marion or Mansfield Hospitals); \$800 at one's own community-based site
- "Clinical" work to be done at an OhioHealth site or student's own congregational/ministry site
- 14 hours minimum of clinical time per week
- Five hours of peer group time, one day a week
- Group meetings to be held at Marion General and OhioHealth Mansfield Hospitals.
- This unit will be supervised by Rev. Kristin Langstraat, ACPE Supervisor and OhioHealth System Director for Faith Community Relations.
