Ministry Mondays are opportunities for learning about specific All In Community ministry pathways both connectionally and within local congregations that radiate out into the community at-large.

The first minutes, hours, and days after a person's release from incarceration is a most vulnerable time. When there is not adequate support during this initial phase of reentry, the returning neighbor often responds out of desperation to fulfill needs instead of having hope for a better future.

For these returning neighbors, this vulnerable time is often filled with loneliness, hopelessness, and confusion during these transitional moments. Many fall down in the gap without the presence of a caring handoff back into our communities.

Join others during this information session to learn about an inspirational framework designed to guide community members who want to make a difference for those returning home after an incarceration experience. There are gaps in the reentry process that can be filled by providing both tangible help and hopeful presence for returning neighbors. Being welcomed home is the first step to restoring a returning neighbor's dignity, identity, safety, and self-worth.

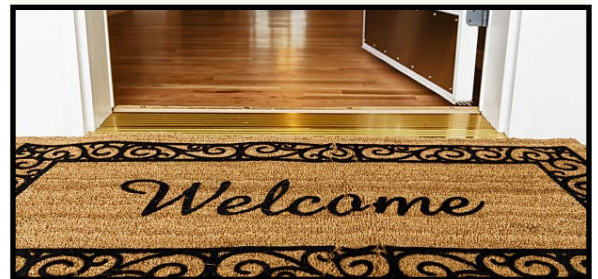
